turbine #15 impacted our home with shadow flicker this morning as the turbine was operating continually
through the sunrise. The Mason County Zoning Ordinance is specific that 10 hours maximum per operational
year shall impact a home. The 10 hour maximum was met on March 7, 2013. Since that time our home has repeatedly
been impacted by flicker. I have never been contacted by or saw a consumers energy representative
attempting in any way to address this continual violation of the ordinance. One year ago today on 8-22-2012
during testing, it was made apparent by my complaint, video and testimony that #15 cast shadow flicker on
our home. Consumers Energy has had a full year to address and remedy this impact but has not done that.
Continually violations of the ordinance are unacceptable. Mary Reilly, Mason County Zoning Administrator
has been in my home several times to witness these impacts. Ms. Reilly was in our home this morning to
witness and video flicker. See attached copy of complaint from one year ago today.
